Here is a selection of our themes, activities, events and experiences that have been chosen by the children, with help from our Club Council.

Monday 13th February – The 40's

Trip to Duxford Imperial War Museum - Additional cost of £3 per child.

IWM Duxford is set within the spacious grounds of the famous former First and Second World War airfield. Lose yourself for a whole day wandering under and around some of the most iconic aircraft in the world and get hands-on with award-winning interactive exhibitions. IWM Duxford is home to an impressive collection of over two hundred aircraft as well as tanks, military vehicles and boats.

On return Wacky will be having a war-time tea, with a homemade Victoria sponge, and a selection of war-time rationed foods. There will be opportunities to build tanks, air-raid shelters, and play with games and toys of the 40's era.

Tuesday 14th February – The 50's

- Play 50's street games, such as marbles, tin tan Tommy, egga or egger, and have a hula-hoop contest, and have a Cowboy and Indian battle.
- Make your own spinning top, paint by numbers; make your own pearl necklaces with fimo.
- **Grease party** – Come dressed, or if preferred, bring along a 50's fancy dress outfit. We shall be making our own movie drive-through to watch the film Grease, then have a themed Grease party with a ice cream bar, French fries, onion rings, and hotdogs for tea. We shall be singing the Grease songs on karaoke, and learning 50's dances such as the Twist, the Hand Jive, and much, much more

Wednesday 15th February – The 60's

- Make a selection of 60's crafts such as dream catchers, lens-less glasses, love beads, friendship bracelets, tin-can telephones, lava lamps, tie-dyeing and even your own pop-art picture.
- Play games such as Twister or Mouse-Trap, play with a Spirograph
- Join us for our 60's themed music festival, with 60's dressing-up costumes, karaoke music, face-painting. Help to make the Wacky camping area, including den building and a beach party.
- England and the World Cup - join us for Wacky World Cup.

Thursday 16th February- The 70's

- Make your own Pet Rocks, Tack Pictures, Foam Star sunglasses, ceramic painting. Make a god's eye or even a bottle with sand art.
- Play games such as Battleships, Connect 4, Yahtzee and Mastermind.
- Make fudge using popping candy
- Take part in our Space-hopper, or our Saturday Night Fever dance competition.
- Sing along with the classic songs of the 70's on the play station.
- Charlie and the Chocolate Factory activities: can you invent your own chocolate bar (cookery), take part in our chocolate treasure hunt, or help to make chocolate play-dough.

Friday 17th February – The 80's.

- Play with board games from the 80's such as the Game of Life, Hungry Hippos, Uno, play with a Rubix Cube.
- Make your own bold coloured jewellery, and retro crafts.
- Make your own Blue Peter badge, and a Tracy Island.
- Make a DeLorean from Back to the Future.
- Or take part in our Michael Jackson Moon Dance competition, or our aerobics class, or even have a go on roller skates. (If your child has their own skates, please feel free to bring them along, with any safety clothing.
- 80's face-painting, dressing up, singing, and neon glow-sticks.
